U.S. Secretary of State Hillary Rodham Clinton is traveling to Hawaii, Vietnam, China, Cambodia, Malaysia, Papua New Guinea, New Zealand, and Australia October 27-November 8, 2010.

On October 28 Secretary Clinton delivered a major policy speech on the U.S. role as a Pacific nation in Hawaii at the beginning of a 13-day visit to the Asia-Pacific region at an event sponsored by the [East-West Center](#). The Secretary expressed U.S. support for an international inquiry into human rights abuses that have been committed by Burma's ruling military junta, and pledged that the United States would stand with Asian leaders and individuals who are willing to take action to improve the lives of everyday citizens.
